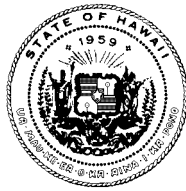

SUBJECT: CHANGES TO BILLING LOCAL CODES

The Med-QUEST Division (MQD) will be converting all current local codes to national standard codes as of October 16, 2003.

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) requires that local codes be replaced by national HCFA Common Procedural Coding System (HCPCS) codes. The Hawaii Medicaid Program has crossed-walked local codes to national 2003 HCPCS codes. The following table lists the local codes that require authorization and the national codes to which they have been crossed-walked.

Current Code	Replacement National Code	Description
W9000	T1015HD	Family Planning, routine visit, all inclusive
W9900	T1015-22	Family Planning visit (initial and annual) to include breast and pelvic exam, counseling, PAP smear and interpretation by a qualified laboratory, STD screening, all necessary lab work per protocols, diaphragms, jelly, foam, condoms, and thermometers
W9900-52	T1015-U1	Family planning problem visit, includes pregnancy assessment and referral, interval family planning management, examination, lab work as necessary, and contraception supplies
W9900-22	T1015-U2	Family Planning visit, includes all of T1015-22 plus one year supply of birth control pills.

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For services performed on or after October 16, 2003, please use the national codes instead of the local codes. For services performed before October 16, 2003, please use the existing local codes, regardless of the date the claim is submitted to Med-QUEST for payment.
