SUBJECT: ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD SURVEY

The Med-QUEST Division (MQD) is asking for you to complete a survey so that we can learn more about our Medicaid provider interest, readiness, and capacity to electronically exchange healthcare information. The survey is expected to take 10-15 minutes to complete and can be accessed at:

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requires all states to report data on the adoption and implementation of health information technology. The MQD will use information from the survey solely for program development purposes and to report aggregate information to CMS.

With the establishment of the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009, EPs and EHs can receive incentive payments to adopt, implement, upgrade or meaningfully use electronic health record (EHR) technology through the Medicare and Medicaid EHR Incentive Programs. Hawaii Medicaid providers have been able to participate in the Hawaii Medicaid EHR Incentive Program since October 2013.
