ADVANCE PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES WITH PRESCRIPTIVE  
AUTHORITY TO PRESCRIBE PSYCHOTROPIC MEDICATIONS  
EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007

Act 039, Session Laws of Hawaii (SLH) 2007, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to Psychotropic Medication" became law on July 1, 2007. Act 039 now requires that Hawaii Medicaid provide equal access to psychotropic medication for all Medicaid recipients by allowing prescriptions to be written by either a licensed psychiatrist, physician or advance practice registered nurse (APRN) with prescriptive authority under Chapter 457, duly licensed in the State. Pharmacy claims with a date of service of July 1, 2007 or later are impacted by this new Act. (Act 039 amends Act 311, SLH 2006 which requires Hawaii Medicaid to provide access to psychotropic medications for the treatment of mental or emotional disorders when these medications are prescribed by a licensed psychiatrist or physician).

An updated list of psychotropic medications is attached for your reference. Please refer to Provider Memorandum P05-11 for program policies which have not been changed by this memorandum.
